5. Treasurers Report

£28,000 has been paid towards the Parish Share. A further £30,000 is due later in the year. Hill & Dale is in a healthy financial state so is the income and expenditure for the Parish with £49,000 of income received and £46.000 paid out so far this year. St Andrew's Restoration Fund has had a refund of VAT of £3,811 and St Martin's has had a donation to its Fabric Fund of £1,400 from the charitable trust associated with the late Jackie Swan.

6.Church Wardens Reports

- a) Cliddesden . Preparations are in hand for the Quinquennial Inspection later in the year and an update of the Terrier.
- b) Dummer . Looking to make improvements on a path near the church. "A PCC minute is required to approve the renewal of edging of the paths leading to All Saints Porch door. A quote has been obtained for re-edging and shingling of £1160 and this will be funded from All Saints Restricted Fund."
- c) Ellisfield . A PCC minute is required to approve the replacement of the notice board at the entrance to St Martins. The present one is over 25 years old and is falling apart. A quote has been obtained for a new notice board from Greenbarnes Ltd who were used by Ellisfield Parish Council , of £1,116 (inclusive of VAT). VAT can be reclaimed back and there is a likely erection cost of £100. The

intention is to have it dedicated in memory of Jackie Swan whose family has been very generous over many years. A Faculty may be required. **ALL PRESENT INDICATED THEIR SUPPORT FOR THE PROJECT**

d) Farleigh Wallop . Treatment for green slime in porch to be undertaken.
